

Public Research Keeps Agriculture Productive

As a California farmer, Stewart Resnick relies on university research to address the real challenges facing agriculture. New pests and crop threats can emerge quickly, and without research-backed solutions, entire harvests can be lost.

Resnick points to the land-grant university system as essential to the future of farming. Because agriculture is highly fragmented, individual growers cannot fund this work on their own. Federally supported research ensures universities can continue developing the knowledge that keeps food production viable and communities fed.
